簡介

本工作坊將聚焦於烏克蘭戰爭對東歐與東亞社會的衝擊與意涵。對於這些各自坐落於差異甚大的社會政治脈絡之中的各個社會，我們欲發展出跨國的對話，討論這場戰爭對於烏克蘭以及其鄰國——例如立陶宛與波蘭——的意義，以及其如何也以某種鏡像效應的方式粗暴地提醒了東亞各國——從台灣、日本到南韓——他們所面對的政治現實。俄羅斯的軍事侵略打開了新帝國主義與極權主義偽善的潘朵拉盒子，對許多國家的民主與主權造成威脅。無論戰爭結果如何，烏克蘭人民的抗爭反抗了俄羅斯以及其他潛在侵略者的意志，例如對台灣虎視眈眈的北京。烏克蘭人與俄國社會為了這一切所付出的龐大代價，也許長遠看來，並不會只是徒勞。同時，這場戰爭也對烏克蘭與其他國家的社會學家造成挑戰，促使我們反思戰爭如何對各自的社會造成影響。

Introduction

The workshop will focus on the impact of the war in Ukraine and its implications for Eastern European and East Asian societies. In spite of very different sociopolitical contexts, we aim to develop a transnational dialogue about what this war means for Ukraine and its immediate neighbors such as Lithuania and Poland, and by a sort of mirror effect, what this brutal reminder implies for Eastern Asia, starting with Taiwan, as well as Japan and South Korea. The Russian military aggression has opened the Pandora's box of neo-imperial and totalitarian pretensions, threatening the democracy and the sovereignty of many countries. Irrespective of the final outcome of this war, the resistance of Ukrainian people is running against the intentions of the Russian aggressor and other candidates for similar venture, such as Beijing's appetite over Taiwan. The price paid for all this by the Ukrainian as well Russian societies is huge, but one may hope it will not be futile in the long run. In the meantime, this war implies many challenges for sociologists of Ukraine and other countries to analyze how this war is affecting their respective societies.
